

2019-2020 Study Abroad Grant Request Form

All students at Columbus State University may apply for these funds and may receive a monetary award for study abroad based on the duration of the program. Students must have applied or been accepted into a study abroad program. The award must be applied to educational costs incurred through a study abroad program. If the student is unable to participate in the program for any reason, all funds awarded must be returned to Columbus State University. Awards are given on a "first come, first served" basis until funds are expended for that cycle. If selected to receive a Center for Global Engagement Grant, students are expected to complete 5 hours of service within one year of their program's return.

Eligibility Requirements

To receive a CSU Study Abroad Grant, you must:

- Be 18 or older by the time the study abroad program begins
- Be enrolled (with deposit paid) in a CSU approved credit-bearing study abroad program
- Be a currently enrolled Columbus State University student at the time the grant is requested
- Have attended CSU and taken classes for at least one full semester prior to the study abroad program's term
- Be in good academic standing (minimum 2.0 GPA or above)
- Agree to complete 5 hours of service to the CGE within one year of your program's return date.

Note: Students are only eligible for one award per academic year.

Submission Requirements

- The application must be submitted during the correct submission period in order to be considered. Contact CGE if you are unsure of the correct dates applicable to your program.
- A valid photo ID (i.e. CSU ID or driver's license) must be presented by the student submitting the Grant Request Form.
- No applications can be submitted on behalf of another student. No applications will be accepted from individuals other than the applicant whose name is on the form.

Receiving an Award

- Students will receive an email informing them whether or not they are approved for funding.
- For CSU faculty-led programs, the award amount will be applied directly toward program costs.
- For all other programs, students will be issued a check in the amount of their award.
- If for any reason a student cannot participate in study abroad they will need to return the funds to CSU.
- Failure to complete 5 hours of service to the CGE within one year of the program's return date will ensure a hold be placed on their student account until the award funds are paid back in full.
